Antenna Day 2019




Old Business- The contract with Bucks County Community for the 2024 Hamfest was signed.

Do you wonder how Comcast/Xfinity keeps their cable internet and TV amplifiers up during an outage?


Yes, that is a Honda generator bungee-corded to a pole atop a cable amplifier just up the road from my house in Milford Twp. - KS3Z
